Audition file submission instructions



Thanks for your interest in KWLT's March Madness 2021! If you can't make it out to our live online auditions on February 27th, you're welcome to send us audio (or video) files for your audition instead. Here's what we're expecting:

- A brief (30-60 second) monologue that gives us a sense of your range.
- Pick two of the five speeches below, and record them with two distinctly different characterizations.

Please take the time to submit your best work: listen to your recordings and make sure that you're satisfied with them.
